The group consists of carers or former carers, who use email to keep in touch

The carers can be distant or hands on carers if they own their own computer but the loan computers are normally only available to hands on carers

Carers can use their own computers or loan one from CLICK to enable them to join the group

CLICK

CLICK aims to link, inform and support carers who are isolated because they live in rural areas, or who live in urban communities but are isolated because of their caring role

CLICK provides a support group on line, giving carers social interaction and support by linking them via email or through a messenger service as a viable alternative to attending regular support meetings which can be difficult for some people

CLICK members are given the email addresses of other members together with a brief introduction

CLICK members are asked to send a minimum of one group email per month in order to keep their membership live

CLICK members are free to share other information as they wish and are free to use the computer and email as much or as little as they wish

CLICK members get together in person once or twice year
