1. If you wish to object to the proposed registration you have 4 weeks from the day on which this notice is given to you to do so in writing. Any objections should be sent to the Court of Protection (**address at the end of this form**) and should contain the following details:

- Your name and address
- Any relationship to the donor
- If you are not the donor, the name and address of the donor
- The name and address of the attorney
- The grounds for objecting to the registration of the enduring power of attorney

Note: The instrument means the enduring power of attorney made by the donor which it is sought to register

The attorney(s) does not have a relative. Relatives are not entitled to know of the existence of the enduring power of attorney prior to being given this notice

Note: This is addressed only to the donor

Note: This notice should be signed by every one of the attorneys who are applying to register the enduring power of attorney

2. The grounds on which you object are:

- That the power purported to be created by the instrument is not valid as an enduring power of attorney
- That the power created by the instrument no longer subsists
- That the application is premature because the donor is not yet becoming mentally incapable
- That fraud or undue pressure was used to induce the donor to make the power
- That the attorney is unsuitable to be the donor's attorney (having regard to all the circumstances and in particular the attorney's relationship to or connection with the donor).

3. You are informed that while the enduring power of attorney remains registered, you will not be able to revoke it until the Court of Protection confirms the revocation.
