105* - Good News Story - an older couple, one with mobility issues, had registered for additional emergency help because of their situation. They had a power cut at 11.45pm on Monday 19th December. They rang the emergency number that was answered immediately by a pleasant, helpful person. She asked a few questions and said she could see that they were registered for support. Within 30 minutes a team arrived to check the power to the house and found it was a problem with high voltage. They worked outside until 2.45am when power was reconnected. On the Tuesday, they arrived just after 9.00am to say they had found the cause of the problem and needed to turn off the power to the house for 2 hours to do a permanent repair. Two hours later the power was back on and the team checked to ensure everything was OK.

At a time when we hear about a lot of bad news, we need to say congratulations to OVO power (formerly Scottish and Southern) on their helpful attitude and excellent service.
