Romsey Disabled People Partnership Last Wednesday of each month from 11am-1pm at Romsey Town Hall.



extra help is available to people, in vulnerable situations, who have extra communication, access, safety or health needs. PSR updates your request to energy suppliers to whom you pay your bills and your regional network companies including gas, electricity and water. www.thepsr.co.uk/

Benefits of signing up to the priority service

- Support and information during a power or gas supply interruption
- Connection to local emergency services
- Emergency power
- **Emergency gas**
- Communication tailored to your needs
- Nominated contact
- Peace of mind

People who can sign up for the service include: (although this list is not exhaustive)

- Disabled
- Chronically sick
- Bedridden
- Living with dementia
- Of pensionable age
- Living with children under 5
- Experiencing mental health issues
- Living with learning difficulties
- Unable to speak English

You can also sign up temporarily if you are experiencing difficulties in your life such as a bereavement, pregnancy or recovering from an operation.
