'Leaving hospital' leaflet for patients, families and carers

Carers Together has put together a useful contact list of voluntary and statutory organisations that can offer help and support when you or your loved one is discharged from hospital. As well as some other useful contact details, such as hospital phone numbers. Available on request from Carers Together Office, website and our Charity Shops.

Your Choice Your Support

Are you a carer in need of a helping hand? Our 'Take a Break' service offers flexible help should you need short term respite from caring. This service is also available if you live alone and need some help to remain independent.

Your Choice Your Support

Our Support Workers are caring, reliable and experienced. They can assist you, or the person you care for, with daily tasks such as shopping and errands, food preparation, light cleaning duties, laundry, transport and trips out, or simply offer companionship.

Support Workers are fully vetted and DBS checked. The cost of this service is £15 per hour plus 45p per mile if the Support Worker takes you out. A startup fee of £25, payable when the Coordinator first visits, will be offset against your first invoice. Please note, personal care is not provided.

Support Worker Vacancies - Part Time

Are you looking for a flexible job within the community? We are seeking Support Workers to provide personalised support, tailored to the individual client needs. No personal care is involved. Our clients may need help with daily tasks such as shopping, light cleaning duties, food preparation, transport and trips out or simply companionship. We can offer £9.50 per hour, plus holiday pay and 45 pence per mile should you take the client out. This is a zero-hour contract and hours are arranged directly by support workers with the client as and when required. The ideal candidates will have previous care experience and must be enthusiastic, reliable and trustworthy. The position will be subject to a successful DBS check and references.
